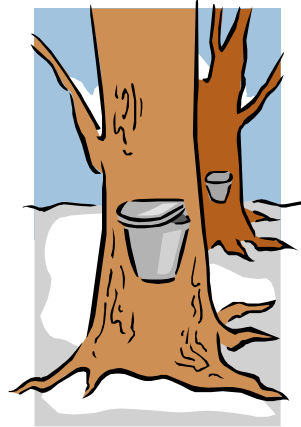


# Maple Syrup Saturday
